## 1 Day ISO 22301 Professional Workshop

### Course description:

This workshop is designed to give an overview of the standard ISO 22301 and the steps required to implement a Business Continuity Management System using the same. ISO 22301 was released in May 2012 hence this is the first and right step in understanding this new standard for implementation, migration (from BS 25999 or any other standard), preparing for being audited or auditing according to ISO 22301. Training methodologies include classroom training, videos and group discussions. Knowledge checks and quizzes are made use of in order to enhance the participant learning experience and knowledge retention.

The workshop will be followed by a 25 questions, 30 minutes, exam of objective type questions. Those who clear this exam (scoring minimum 60%) will receive 'ISO 22301 Professional' certification.
