CISA certification description:

Enterprises demand IS audit professionals that possess the knowledge and expertise to help them identify critical issues and customize practices to support trust in and value from information systems.

The skills and practices that CISA promotes and evaluates are the building blocks of success in the field. Possessing the CISA demonstrates proficiency and is the basis for measurement in the profession.

The CISA designation is a globally recognized certification for IS audit control, assurance and security professionals. Being CISA-certified showcases your audit experience, skills and knowledge, and demonstrates you are capable to assess vulnerabilities, report on compliance and institute controls within the enterprise.

The CISA exam tests one's competence in the 5 domains of job practice areas, which cover:

- Domain 1—The Process of Auditing Information Systems (21%)
- Domain 2—Governance and Management of IT (16%)
- Domain 3—Information Systems Acquisition, Development and Implementation (18%)
- Domain 4—Information Systems Operations, Maintenance and Service Management (20%)
- Domain 5—Protection of Information Assets (25%)

- IS / IT Consultants
- IS / IT Audit Managers
- Security Systems Engineer
- Chief Information Officer
- Security Professionals
- Non-IT Auditors
- CAs who wants to get into IT Audit
- Any IT professional
- IT Managers

Prerequisites to become CISA

This course is designed for individuals who have A minimum of 5 years of professional information systems auditing, control or security work experience (as described above in the CISA job practice areas) is required for certification. Substitutions and waivers of such experience, to a maximum of 3 years, may be obtained in certain cases.

The work experience for CISA certification must be gained within the 10-year period preceding the application date for certification or within 5 years from the date of originally passing the exam. Note that candidates have 5 years from the passing date to apply for certification.
