Training Course Adapting Simulation Approach - SimulTrain®

Workshop description:

This 2-days computer-based simulator SimulTrain® training course, prepared in collaboration with Sauter Training & Simulation – Switzerland, trains the attendees on those skills necessary for anyone involved in projects realization including project managers, team members, and senior management. Attendees will acquire the core project management competencies as well as teamwork and leadership skills in an enjoyable way.

How it works:

SimulTrain® is a simulation of the planning and execution phases of a medium-sized project. A team of four participants plays the role of a project manager. The “project manager” must finish the project plan and manage its execution. Full of multimedia interaction, SimulTrain® provides the teams with phone calls, emails, and voicemails to create a realistic and stressful environment – just as in real life. The simulation is split into two parts over a two-days period and combined with a brief refresher session about project management standard by PMI® (Project Management Institute) to bring all attendees to the same level of understanding about project management.

The simulation confronts the attendees with life-like situations testing their planning & managerial skills.

Project Management Simulation focuses on:

- Technical competencies for project management.
- Behavioral competencies for project management

Learning Objectives:

- A hands-On experience of running a project.
- Emphasis on the human factor element while managing a project.
- Team dynamics and the way project team members interact among themselves during the various project phases, and how the way that the team reacts to a specific the situation, dictates the final outcome of the project.

Who should attend?

- All personnel involved in projects' activities.
- Project Managers, Leaders, Coordinators & Team Members.
- Individuals holding PMI® certifications (PMP®, CAPM®, etc...) aiming to collect PDUs to maintain their certifications.
- This session isn't an introduction to project management, but rather an advanced course aimed at sharpening the project management skills of the attendees.
